

Guidelines, Booking Terms & Conditions Newcastle Bellydance Festival Dated 14 January 2018

I accept and agree to the following terms & conditions prior to proceeding with Payment online, by phone or in person for all bookings relating to the Newcastle Bellydance Festival.

I am over 18 Years of Age or the Parent Guardian of a minor aged 12 or over.

Workshops

A separate booking for each participant is required, multiple participant bookings for workshops will not be accepted. Workshop packages can not be shared between participants.

Photo ID is required on entry to each workshop with your receipt order.

Workshop packages (in entirety) and event entry tickets may be transferred at your request to another individual's name. All transfers attract an administration fee of \$10.00 per product. Please send an email to newcastlebellydance@gmail.com with your Booking Details and the details of the new participant, including name, mobile phone & email address.

Children under the age of 18 attending workshops MUST be booked by a Parent/Guardian. The minimum age requirement for Workshops is 12.

Children including Infants, Friends and Family are NOT permitted under ANY circumstances into a Workshop unless they are a Paid Participant.

In the event of Workshop becoming unavailable, you will be offered a place in another Workshop or a Refund will be issued (pro-rata prices apply to packages).

Please arrive 10 minutes prior to Workshop Start Time to register your attendance.

There are no physical tickets for Workshops, participants will be listed on a Register.

If you arrive Early and there is a Workshop running, please do not enter the room.

If you are attending a following Workshop in the same Venue, you must vacate the Room regardless.

Please wear comfortable clothing and bring water to each workshop.

Do not film or photograph teachers and/or students without permission.

Be Respectful at all times.

Entry to Festival Events

Group bookings for Dance Party, Dance Spectacular & Performers Bazaar are acceptable, however, you must arrive together with your group for entry. Tickets will not be held for individual names.

Your Numbered Receipt from the Online Store is your Entry to your Selected Events at the Festival. I understand I must Print and Present the Receipt on Entry to Each Event at the Registration Table. I understand that I need to Show Photo ID upon request. All Bookings will be confirmed via Email, after Payment is Received.

Dance Party & Concert Tickets are Not Available at the Door due to Catering & Seating Arrangements. Only excess tickets if applicable will be available for purchase at the Bookings Desk & at the Door for an additional cost of \$10.00 to the full price listed.

Children

The minimum age for attendance to the Dance Party & Concert is 15 and minors must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

Receipts

Online Bookings: Your Paypal Receipt is your Proof of Purchase. Please print and retain a copy if required. (This is not your Entry Document into Festival Events)

Booking Fees

A Booking Fee of 3.2% applies to all Festival Bookings

Cancellations & Refunds

Refunds do not apply to Workshops, Dance Party, Concert & Bazaar Bookings for cancellations, non-attendance or non-participation under any circumstances. You may transfer workshops/tickets to another person. All exchanges and transfers attract an administration fee of \$10.00.

Tickets

No physical Tickets are sent out. You must print your Numbered Order which lists your Events. You will receive a confirmation email once payment has been processed.

Concert Seating

There is no reserved seating. Some areas are Reserved for Performers & Concert Staff Only. It is a condition of Entry that you show your Receipt to the Door Staff for Entry/Re-Entry after Intermission. Group Bookings must arrive together for Entry.

Sunday Entries

Can be Purchased At The Door. You will receive a Wrist Band for All-Day Entry. It is a condition of Entry that you wear the Wristband and present it to the Door Staff. Group Bookings must arrive together for Entry.
